This social enterprise runs online centres in Deloraine and Mole Creek, In 2013, MVC Inc decided to publish the Meander Valley Gazette in response to the need for a local newspaper. This decision was a natural extension of a commitment to provide local access to information, education and community connection.

The Meander Valley extends from the western suburbs of Launceston to Cradle Mountain National Park.

Situated between Devonport and Launceston, off the Bass Highway, with easy access to the Spirit of Tasmania Terminal and Launceston Airport, the Valley is a predominantly rural municipality.

Proximity to interstate connections and the major population centres of Burnie, Devonport and Launceston has made it a popular place to set up a business or just settle into the quiet pace of life.

The Valley contains many historic sites and areas of great natural beauty, such as the Cradle Mountain and Walls of Jerusalem National Parks.

Deloraine is home to the Tasmanian Craft Fair and a thriving creative community – a hub for music, arts and crafts across northern Tasmania.


